Greetings from Paramaribo;

Good afternoon. We had hopped to send these every other week. But every third week seems to happen so here we are. We can't talk to each of you often so hope these notes help communicate of our ministry.

Although our September has been a blur. Today I want to share a little bit of our month.

Diana works Fridays at the International Academy of Suriname school. As with everything she takes on, she is all in on this as well. Tackling updating the catalogue of books after years of neglect, making everything neat and tidy, and challenging the kids to read books through "Really cool prizes and awards". She likes it when the kids recognize her at church or in the store and say Hi!

Marc is one of MAF Suriname's newer pilots. MAF Suriname is a little different than most MAF programs. We bring pilots onboard who don't meet the experience requirements to fly in more challenging programs. They fly with instructor pilots for 50 or so hours, then once qualified, they secure a Surinamese commercial License. At that point they start Solo Mission flying as MAF Suriname pilots. Then after a year they have experience and hours to move on to more challenging programs and bigger faster aircraft.

After unfortunate events, many delays, obstacles, and hardships, Marc made his first operational Solo flight this month. Congratulations Marc.
